



WHAT? Come fish, eat, drink and relax with us on Galveston bay to raise money for great causes. There will be a raffle, silent auction, zydeco music, seafood buffet and much more! You DO NOT have to fish to join in on the fun!

WHEN AND WHERE? Friday September 9th at Sunrise Where: The Tournament is being held at The Waterman's Restaurant & Marina - 14302 Stewart Road in Galveston.

WHAT ELSE? – If you plan to fish, there is a room block at Moody Gardens for our group.


HOW DO I SIGN UP? Scan the QR code below. Once you are on the sight, scroll down to upcoming events and click the more information tab.



SO MANY QUESTIONS? HERE IS THE BEST WAY TO IMAGINE THE FESTIVITIES!

WHAT DO I GET IF I BUY A WHOLE BOAT? – Start by putting together a group of agent friends, client or family that will join you on a guided fishing trip led by a licensed professional fishing guide who will take you fishing. The guide will provide ALL the tackle, bait and expertise you will need to have a memorable day on the bay! Expect an early start and plan to be off the water by 12:30 at the latest for the weigh in and party. Drinks and snacks will be provided on the boat for you so all you must do is show up ready to have a great time! Your entry also provides for a lunch ticket for each fisherman on the boat. What if I want to fish but can't buy a whole boat? - There is an option for an individual spot for \$250 and we will put a boat of four fisherman together to form a team. Same benefits as buying a whole boat.

WHAT IF WE WANT TO ASK OUT OF OUR OWN BOAT? – GO For it! You can register to fish using your own boat for \$600 and that will also provide you a lunch ticket for the party. What if I don't want to fish but I want yo join in on the fun? – COME ON! You can buy an individual ticket on the site that includes your lunch ticket. There will be lots of festivities, food, fun and beverages to keep you entertained. Seeing the fish coming to the weigh in is always a great time and the weather is forecast to be perfect that day!





QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

I DON'T FISH BUT I WANT TO JOIN IN ON THE FUN? – COME ON! You can buy an individual ticket on the site that includes your lunch ticket. There will be lots of festivities, food, fun and beverages to keep you entertained. Seeing the fish coming to the weigh in is always a great time and the weather is forecast to be perfect that day! Non-fisherman are able to purchase tickets and join us for the party! Fishing starts at sunrise and the party starts at 11:00 AM with a Zydeco band, seafood buffet and cash bar. The fish Weigh in starts at 11:30 so come cheer on your friends and co-workers as they show off their catch!


WHAT IF I CAN'T MAKE IT? – You can purchase raffle tickets and bid on the silent auction. On the site there is an option to purchase raffle ticket, please look at the prizes and buy a book of five for \$20. What's the deadline? – We have 40 boats to fill by Friday August 19th and lots of interest in this event. Get signed up ASAP!

FISHING PARTICIPANTS NEED TO BE AT WATERMAN'S RESTAURANT & MARINA - 6:00 AM SHARP!

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING? - Texas Saltwater Fishing License (at least 1 day), small ice chest for your day's catch, hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, light jacket, shoes that do not have black soles. What will the fishing guide provide? - Rods, reels, and fishing tackle (feel free to bring your own rod and reel if you wish) - ALL bait will be provided. Will I be able to see land the entire time on the boat? - Yes!

DO I NEED A FISHING LICENSE? YES. Anyone planning to participate in the tournament will require at least a 1 day saltwater fishing license. They can be purchased on line at https://tpdw.texas.gov/business/licenses/online_sales/# OR at any local Academy, Dicks Sporting goods etc. LICENSING WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE TO PURCHASE THE DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT AND MUST BE PURCHASED IN ADVANCE.

HOW MUCH IS A 1 DAY SALTWATER FISHING LICENSE?- \$11 How long will we be fishing for? -You need to be in the weigh-in line no later than 12:30 pm. How man y fisherman are on each boat? - 4 fisherman per boat + the fishing guide (You do however have the option to purchase the entire boat and have anywhere between 1-4 anglers)





QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

ARE NON-FISHERMAN ALLOWED TO RIDE ON THE BOAT? - No, only the 4 fisherman are allowed to go out on the boats.

IF I HAVE A FRIEND ATTENDING THE TOURNAMENT AS WELL, CAN WE BE PUT ON THE SAME BOAT? - Yes please send all requests to lauren.riechmann@gibraltarlending.com and we will try to accommodate the request as best as we can. REQUEST MUST BE IN BY FRIDAY, AUG 26, 2022

WHAT IF THE WEATHER IS BAD AND WE CAN'T GO OUT ON THE WATER? - The tournament director reserves the right to cancel in case of inclement weather. If the tournament is canceled due to inclement weather, ALL updates will be posted to the Home page on this website by 10 PM on Thursday, Sept 8th, 2022. Entrants are responsible to verify the tournament is not canceled.


SO WHAT IF THE TOURNAMENT IS CANCELED DUE TO BAD WEATHER? - We will look to reschedule at a later date.

PEARL MUSUEM

She served on the boards of the American Heart Association, The Tomball Regional Arts Committees, The Centrum Arts League, and the Pearl Fincher Museum of Fine Arts. The museum was named in honor of Pearl Fincher for her significant contributions to the community of Greater Northwest Houston.

THE MAN & WOMAN OF THE YEAR CAMPAIGN

One of our own Melissa Mae was nominated for this prestigious award which is a 10-week fundraising competition that raises funds to benefit the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society (LLS) fund important, life-saving research for various forms of blood cancer.

BACKPACK MINISTRIES

They identify families in the community who are struggling. They purchase food, clothing, hygeine products and backpacks. They fill the backpacks with school supplies and distribute donations help families to prepare for the upcoming school year.

TOMAGWA

Provides compassionate healthcare to community members with limited resources by offering, medical, dental, vision, lab, pharmacy, and case management services. This donation was to help the ministry fill 100 backpacks for kids in need with school supplies.

SWING FOR A CURE

The foundation was a sponsor for the "swing for a cure" golf tournament which benefits the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Only 30,000 children and adults have this disease and the drug companies do not consider this a large enough amount for the population to do much research.
